WORKSHOPS AT NORWICH CATHEDRAL, NORWICH, NORFOLK

Get off Auto Workshops and Travel and Street workshops.

In Norwich we run Get off Auto and Travel and Street workshops and both start in the Refectory in the Cathedral.

HOW TO GET THERE

Norwich Cathedral is well served by bus links, several of which all stop outside the Cathedral.

By Train. The Cathedral is only a short walk from Norwich train station along the riverside. Turn right, cross the river and walk along the river footpath for five minutes until you arrive at Pull's Ferry which is the beginning of the Cathedral Close. There turn left and you will see the Cathedral spire ahead of you.

By Car. Norwich is easily accessed from most major routes. The Cathedral itself has no visitor parking, but there are several public car parks nearby.

REFRESHMENTS

As we are meeting in a coffee shop, please buy yourself a drink (feel free to add in a snack). The first part of each session is a presentation so there is plenty time for you to enjoy a cuppa/cake and as we are taking up a table it's only fair that we all partake in something from the options available.

WHAT TO BRING ON PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOPS & PHOTO WALKS:

- You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged batteries and a spare battery if you have one.
- Memory card – Please make sure there is one in your camera with sufficient space.
- A camera bag is useful for protecting your camera and equipment when outdoors, and a transparent plastic bag and some sticky tape make a good, temporary waterproof cover for your camera and an umbrella will protect your equipment and you in wet weather.
- Dress in warm, comfortable clothing for outdoor sessions. A waterproof/ windproof top will be useful. Comfortable footwear is advised for photographing outdoors.
- Garden kneelers or something similar are useful for getting low perspective shots (Travel and Street session only)
