HOW TO GET THERE

Clophill Eco Lodges

Directions

The High Street in the village of Clophill starts at the Flying Horse Public House which is just to the north of the roundabout at the intersection of the A6 and A507 in Bedfordshire. Proceed east along the High Street for approximately half a mile, passing a school on the right and a church on the left. Continue past a wide road on your left ("Townshott") and after 100 yards there is a small lane on the left ("Old Church Path") opposite a white cottage on the right. There is a small sign indicating Clophill Eco Lodges.

Proceed uphill along "Old Church Path" (single track uneven lane with limited passing places so care is required) for 500 yards and then turn left where indicated into the car park for the Eco Lodges.

By Road from M1, Junction 13

Take the A507 (Woburn Road) south towards Flitwick and continue on A507 until reaching the roundabout intersected by the A6. Turn left at the roundabout and immediately right into Clophill High Street, then follow directions above.

By Road from Bedford

From Bedford, take the A6 south towards Luton until reaching the roundabout intersected by the A507. Turn left immediately before the roundabout into Clophill High Street, then follow directions above.

By Road from Luton

From Luton, take the A6 north towards Bedford until reaching the roundabout intersected by the A507. Go across the roundabout and turn right immediately afterwards into Clophill High Street, then follow directions above.

By Road from A1 intersection with the A507

Take the A507 west towards Shefford and continue the Clophill until reaching the roundabout intersected by the A6. Turn right at the roundabout and turn right immediately afterwards into Clophill High Street, then follow directions above.

By Public Transport

Clophill Eco Lodges is not easily accessible by public transport but the following train stations are nearby

Flitwick 4 miles

Arlesey 6 miles

Bedford 10 miles

WHAT TO WEAR

WHAT TO BRING

- You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged batteries and a spare battery is recommended.
- Please bring all your lenses if you have an interchangeable lens camera. A macro lens is desirable for the closeup and macro photography workshop but is not essential; short to medium focal length zoom lenses with ability to focus closely will be fine for most subjects.
- You are advised to bring the instruction manuals for your camera, lenses and other equipment
- Sufficient memory cards for several hundred images and preferably empty and newly formatted
- We will provide lighting and other equipment as required. However if you have the following equipment then please bring it along: a tripod (full height), flashgun, remote shutter release, extension tubes, close-up filters
