HOW TO GET THERE

The venue for the course is the visitor centre at Brimham Rocks.

11 miles from Harrogate off B6165, 4 miles from Pateley Bridge off B6265

The address is Brimham Moor Road, Summerbridge, Harrogate, North Yorkshire, HG3 4DW but Sat Nav only gives approximate location but it is well signposted.

There is a Pay and Display car park with free parking for NT Members

There is a good 5/10 minute walk up to the visitor centre from the car park. We meet by the kiosk to the right of the visitor centre.

ACCESS

This venue would be challenging for anyone with a disability. However, there is a mobility scooter available to hire in advance free of charge. Please contact Pandora to discuss suitability of this workshop with regard to access.

REFRESHMENTS

Please bring your own if required. The Visitor Centre has a small kiosk serving light refreshments.

WHAT TO BRING ON PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOPS & PHOTO WALKS:

- You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged batteries and a spare battery is recommended.
- Memory card – it is essential that you start the day with an empty, preferably newly formatted, memory card.
- A camera bag is useful for protecting your camera and equipment when outdoors, and a transparent plastic bag and some sticky tape make a good, temporary waterproof cover for your camera and an umbrella will protect your equipment and you in wet weather.
- Bring a tripod (full height) if you have one (essential for landscape, Low-Light & Fill-In Flash and Water & Movement workshops).
- Bring a pen to make any notes.
- Dress in warm, comfortable clothing for outdoor sessions. A waterproof/ windproof top will be useful. Comfortable but strong footwear is advised for photographing outdoors, plus a garden kneeler or similar for getting low for some photos.
