CAMBRIDGE

There are several workshops listed under Cambridge

TRAVEL AND STREET

These are held in the center of the city and we will meet up in a coffee shop for a brief chat before heading off around the streets to spot and take our images. Times for these workshops are advised in the workshop listings. Exact joining instructions will be advised in your workshop email which will arrive roughly a week prior to the session.

What to bring on Travel and Street Photo walks

- You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged batteries and a spare battery if you have one.
- Memory card – it is essential that you start the day with an empty, preferably newly formatted, memory card.
- A camera bag is useful for protecting your camera and equipment when outdoors, and a transparent plastic bag and some sticky tape make a good, temporary waterproof cover for your camera and an umbrella will protect your equipment and you in wet weather.
- Dress in warm, comfortable clothing for outdoor sessions. A waterproof/ windproof top will be useful. Comfortable but strong footwear is advised for photographing outdoors.

CREATIVE PORTRAITS

This workshop is held in my studio in Burwell and usually runs from 10am to 4pm.

What to bring on Creative Portraits Workshops

- You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged batteries and a spare battery if you have one.
- Memory card – it is essential that you start the day with an empty, preferably newly formatted, memory card.
- Something like a 24-105mm or 70-200mm lens or both (or equivalent if you use a crop or micro four thirds camera)
- Wear comfortable clothes we are working with dogs, so you are going to get covered in hair and possibly drooled on.
- Lunch and snacks that you will need to keep you going.
- Travel mug with lid so I can make you a cuppa.
- Your dog if this is a 1-1 session and you have arranged that we use your dog as a model for the session.

CREATIVE MACRO

This workshop is held in my studio in Burwell and usually runs from 10am to 4pm.

What to bring on Creative Macro Workshops

- You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged batteries and a spare battery if you have one.
- Memory card – it is essential that you start the day with an empty, preferably newly formatted, memory card.
- A macro lens or a set of extension tubes or a camera with a macro function. (I have a set of Canon extension tubes I am happy to lend any Canon shooters)
- Spare empty SD card to use for the water drop collisions (This is in case your camera is not compatible with the cables and triggers that I have a selection of. If we can't get your camera to talk to the kit then I will lend you a camera that does hence the need for a spare SD card)

PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOPS

- Wear comfortable clothes. We may well be using food dye and all the various liquids we use are a bit sticky so wear clothes that you don't mind getting messy.
- Lunch and snacks that you will need to keep you going.
- Travel mug with lid so I can make you a cuppa.

PHOTO EDITING

What to bring on Photo Editing Workshops

- Your laptop with editing software installed.
- A selection of images you would like to work on on a memory card.
- A spare empty memory card so I can give you files to take home with you.
