Farne Islands Joining Instructions

HOW TO GET THERE

From the A1 take the turn off onto the B6347 Christon Bank, continue forward onto the B1340. Take the left onto the B1340 Seahouses, at the roundabout take the second exit onto Main Street (B1340). Follow the road until you reach a roundabout and take the second exit onto Seafield Road (B1430), the harbour car park will be on your right.

TIMES & PARKING

The boat will be leaving at 9.30am prompt and we advise all students to arrive at the meeting point at the harbour for 8.45am. You can park in the harbour car park (opposite the harbour) all day for £4. We will meet at Billy Shiels Booking Kiosk at 8.45am prompt, which is with the other boat tour operator kiosks to the left-hand side of the harbour when entering from the main road passing the Life Boat Museum on your left.

Please note : This is a scheduled boat trip so if you are not there on time the boat will leave without you.

REFRESHMENTS & TOILET FACILITIES

Please bring plenty to eat and drink for your day as the Farne Islands do not have cafes. All boats have a toilet onboard and toilets are available on Inner Farne Island in the afternoon. There are no toilets on Staple Island in the morning.

ATTIRE

Take waterproofs/windproofs/warm clothing and sensible footwear as the weather can turn pretty quickly, as well as something to kneel or lie on (optional). Take a hat to protect your head from the diving bombing terns! Plus sunscreen.

CAMERA KIT

Bring your usual camera equipment, tripod/monopod, body, lens wise medium to long zoom (70-200m or 300m+) and wide angle are fine. Spare battery, plenty of cards. Plastic bags for protecting camera and lenses. I usually use freezer bags, plus a black bin bag to pop over camera and tripod if raining. You will have to carry your bag all day so it's a personal judgement about how much to take.

NATIONAL TRUST FEE

National Trust members bring your card for free entry to the islands. If you are not a member of the National Trust there will be a landing fee to pay on each Island which is currently £6.80 per Island.

CANCELLATION DUE TO BAD WEATHER.

I will envisage giving you 48 hours notice if the trip is to be cancelled due to bad weather. I will be in constant contact with the Skipper on the week leading up to the trip. In these circumstances every effort will be made to arrange an alternative date. Should this not be possible, or, you are unable to attend the alternative date then a full refund will be given. If on the day of the course the sea conditions dictate that it is unsafe for the boat to leave the harbour for the Farne Islands then a full refund will be given. If we have set sail but on approaching the Farne Islands the Skipper decides it is unsafe to land, then a refund of the course fee will be made minus the cost of the boat fee. The Skipper's decision is final.
