HOW TO GET THERE

Satellite navigation users

Use Postcode:- FY8 4TQ - THIS BRINGS YOU DIRECTLY TO THE MAIN GATES

From M55

Come off M55 at Junction 4 (uphill). At roundabout turn left onto A583 to Kirkham & Preston but stay in right hand lane. Continue on round next roundabout still on A583 & keep in right hand lane to traffic lights, signpost to Ballam. At lights bear RIGHT diagonally down Peel Road. Follow this country lane until it meets a T junction. Turn right onto Ballam Road. Continue on this road until you enter a 30 m.p.h. zone (Green Drive Golf Club entrance on your left.) Bear right at road fork . Large office complex will appear on left, SERCO. Directly opposite is the Main Entrance to Lytham Hall. It is a slip road and easy to miss, just before a road called South Park. Drive through the main gate and follow drive until Hall appears then drive across front of the building. Follow the drive around until you reach the Car Parks.

From South via Lytham Town Centre - Follow the brown Tourist Info signs

If approaching from south end of Lytham take right fork into Warton Street and continue straight along into Clifton Street. On reaching the 'piazza' on the left, turn right into Park Street (Stringers Dept. Store on left-hand corner). Proceed over railway bridge. SERCO office buildings are to the right and directly opposite, just after a road called South Park and over the mini roundabout, is the Main Entrance to Lytham Hall. Drive through the main gate and follow drive until Hall appears then drive across in front of the building. Follow the drive around until you reach the Car Parks.

From St Annes - Follow the brown Tourist Info signs

Proceed along Clifton Drive until Lowther Gardens, Lytham. Turn left then right onto main road into Lytham centre. Proceed until 'piazza' area appears on right and directly opposite turn left into Park Street. Drive through the main gate and follow drive until Hall appears then drive across in front of the building. Follow the drive around until you reach the Car Parks.

From the Car Park walk into the Courtyard (NOT the Main Hall Building) and you will see a Going Digital sign on the entrance to the West Wing Boardroom, where the workshop will take place.

REFRESHMENTS

Tea and Coffee will be available on arrival and refreshed at lunchtime. Lunch is available from the Lytham Hall caterers, but needs to be ordered in advance. You will be emailed the menu options once numbers are known

PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOPS

WHAT TO BRING ON PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOPS & PHOTO WALKS:

- You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged batteries and a spare battery if you have one.
- Please bring your camera manual if you have a print copy. If you bring DSLR lenses, a hot-shoe mounted flash or other accessories, please bring the instruction manual too.
- Memory card it is essential that you start the day with an empty, preferably newly formatted, memory
 card. We will use card readers to transfer your images to our computers, but in the event that we are
 not able to do this successfully, please bring your camera to computer data cable too.
- A camera bag is useful for protecting your camera and equipment when outdoors, and a transparent plastic bag and some sticky tape make a good, temporary waterproof cover for your camera and an umbrella will protect your equipment and you in wet weather.
- Bring a tripod if you have one (essential for Close-up & Macro workshops and Water & Movement workshops if you don't have one please get in touch as we have loan tripods, free of charge).
- Dress in warm, comfortable clothing for outdoor sessions. A waterproof/ windproof top will be useful.
 Comfortable but strong footwear is advised for photographing outdoors.
- In addition, it can be quite muddy while out taking photographs, so for the sake of the venue's staff, please bring a change of shoes.
