WHAT TO BRING ON PHOTOGRAPHY CLOSE UP AND MARCO WORKSHOP:

- You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged batteries and a spare battery is recommended.
- You may need your camera instruction manual. Quite often these are available online and so no need to bring a copy with you if this is the case.
- Preferred lenses for the day are a wide angle (zoom or fixed but ideally less than 50mm) for the close up part of the day and a zoom for the walkabout... 250mm or longer is best.
- A camera bag is useful for protecting your camera and equipment when outdoors, and a transparent plastic bag and some sticky tape make a good, temporary waterproof cover for your camera and an umbrella will protect your equipment and you in wet weather.
- Dress in warm, comfortable clothing for outdoor sessions. A waterproof/ windproof top will be useful. Comfortable
 but strong footwear is advised for photographing outdoors, plus a garden kneeler or similar for getting low for some
 photos.
- In addition, it can be quite muddy while out taking photographs, please bring a pair of trainers or indoor boots or shoes to travel home in.
