### **TIMES**

### **WHAT TO BRING ON PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOPS & PHOTO WALKS:**

You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged batteries and a spare battery is highly recommended.

\*\*\*A tripod (full height) is essential for this workshop\*\*\*

A camera bag is useful for protecting your camera and equipment when outdoors, and a transparent plastic bag and some sticky tape make a good, temporary waterproof cover for your camera and an umbrella will protect your equipment and you in wet weather.

Check the weather and dress appropriately as the Quayside can be quite windy . A waterproof/ windproof top will be useful. Comfortable but strong footwear is advised for photographing outdoors.

These joining instructions will be sent to you again a few days before the day of the workshop and also I will advise you of the exact meeting time.

**This workshop involves quite a number of steps and quite steep slopes. As a consequence it may not be suitable for some people.**
