## **WHAT TO BRING ON 3-DAY PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOPS:**

 Warm, waterproof clothing for the outdoor sessions

- ✎ Sturdy footwear
- ✎ Umbrella
- ✎ Some people like to bring garden kneeling mats for getting down low and protecting knees!
- ✎ Camera + manual (it's worth checking your manual – sometimes the printed one you receive only contains basic facts and there's a fully detailed manual on the CD that came with the camera)
- ✎ Lenses – bring any lenses that you have also bring any lens hoods that you have with you
- ✎ Memory cards (I will use card readers to transfer your images to my computer, but in the event that I am not able to do this successfully, please bring your camera to computer data cable too)
- ✎ Batteries + charger + spare batteries –  
**MOST IMPORTANT** Tripod (I will have 2 tripods available for loan). If you have a monopod rather than a tripod, this could also be very useful.
- ✎ Camera bag (useful for protecting camera and equipment when outdoors), a transparent plastic bag and sticky tape make a temporary waterproof cover)
- ✎ Cable / remote release (if you have one).
- ✎ Polarizing, Neutral density, Neutral density graduated filters are all optional.

Extras if you have them.

Thermos flask, drinks bottle, rucksack for walks (optional). Notebook, Pens, Pencil
