HOW TO GET THERE

The ICC is situated in Centenary Square off Broad Street in the centre of Birmingham, post code B1 2EA

A number of car parks are available within close walking distance.

If travelling by rail the ICC is only a short walk from New Street, Snow Hill & Moor Street railway stations.

From the entrance of The ICC from Centenary Square take the lift or stairs situated on the lefthand side to floor 5A, the Executive Rooms, the workshop will be in Exec ROOM 8 and will have a Going Digital sign on the door. If entering from Brindley Square walk through to the opposite door entrance and turn right for the Lift.
