Your photography walk will run from 10.00am to 3.00 pm except the specifically titled **Rutting Walks that run from 1pm to 6pm**. Please arrive 15 minutes before your walk is due to start. Please make sure you follow the special instructions regards clothing.

MEETING POINT

By the Refreshment Van in the Diana Fountain Car park at **10 am** (1pm only for the evening Rutting Walks).

HOW TO GET THERE

Bushy Park, Hampton Court Road, Hampton, Middlesex. TW12 2EJ. Follow the link below to a map of the Park: <http://www.royalparks.gov.uk/Bushy-Park.aspx>

If you are travelling by train, the best station is Hampton Court which is five minutes walk away. Turn right when you leave the station, cross over Hampton Court Bridge, walk up past the palace, follow the road around to the right and you will see the Liongate Hotel on the opposite side of the road which is right next door to the Diana Fountain Bushy Park entrance.

If you are using sat nav please enter the following post code: KT8 9DD. This is the postcode for the Liongate Hotel which is right next door to the gate of Bushy Park. Free parking and disabled parking available in the Diana Fountain Car Park.

All buses from Kingston Upon Thames stop right outside the Park, Car park meeting point is 3 minutes walk from the main gate. If you are travelling by bus, the stop to get off at is the Lion Gate (which is the entrance to Hampton Court Gardens), and the Diana Fountain entrance to Bushy Park is directly opposite.

REFRESHMENTS

Coffee is available in the cafe. For lunch you can either:

- bring a packed picnic lunch
- eat in the on-site cafe

Please bring water to take on your walk.

WHAT TO BRING ON BUSHY PARK PHOTO WALKS:

- You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged batteries and a spare battery is recommended.
- **You will need a zoom lens – 200mm plus lens or 10X compact zoom above for the walks (300mm for full frame cameras).**
- **Please do bring a tripod** (full height) if you have one.
- You will need your fully-detailed camera instruction manual.
- Memory card - it is essential that you start the day with an empty, preferably newly formatted, memory card.
- A camera bag is useful for protecting your camera and equipment when outdoors, and a transparent plastic bag and some sticky tape make a good, temporary waterproof cover for your camera and an umbrella will protect your equipment and you in wet weather.
- Dress in warm, **comfortable clothing for outdoor sessions**. A waterproof/ windproof top will be useful.

Wear clothes that can get dirty if you lie on grass – dark jeans, or combats are best.

- **You are advised not to wear shorts and/or sandals in case of brambles, nettles and ticks.**
- Comfortable but strong footwear is advised for photographing outdoors, dustbin liners provide good protection for kneeling in wet conditions for some photos.
- It is advisable not to wear brightly coloured clothes, as these can frighten the deer.
