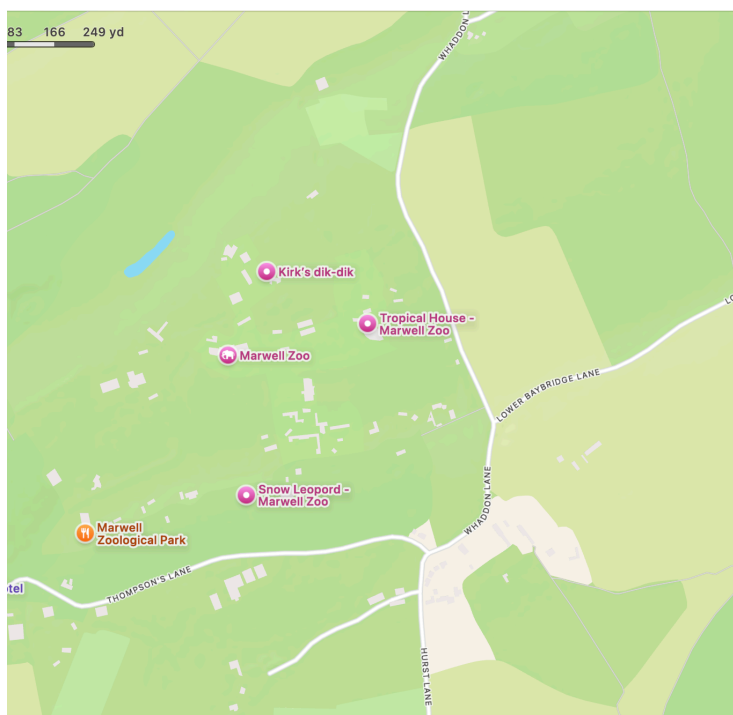
All workshops run from 10am to 3pm. Please meet outside the gift shop at 10am with tickets already purchased.

WHAT TO BRING ON PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOPS & PHOTO WALKS:

- You will need your camera. Ensure it has fresh/fully charged battery and a spare battery if you have one.
- If you have it handy, please bring your cameras manual.
- Memory card - it is essential that you start the day with an empty, preferably newly formatted, memory card. It is also recommended to bring a spare memory card should you develop technical difficulties with one.
- A camera bag is useful for protecting your camera and equipment when outdoors, and a transparent plastic bag and some sticky tape make a good, temporary waterproof cover for your camera and an umbrella will protect your equipment and you in wet weather.
- Please feel free to bring a tripod or monopod, however the nature of this experience will involve a lot of movement and you may therefore find a tripod or monopod restrictive.
- Dress in warm, comfortable clothing for outdoor sessions. A waterproof/ windproof top will be useful. Comfortable shoes are recommended as there is a significant amount of walking involved.

PLEASE NOTE - Whilst animals and birds at this venue are captive, we are unable to control their behaviour. Some animals are reclusive and there are no guarantees that certain animals will be on display. The zoo often take animals off display for medical treatments or for enclosure improvements. Your instructor will make every effort to locate the animal and multiple visits will be made to certain enclosures to try and locate the animals. We can therefore not guarantee you will see all the animals available.

In the event the weather forecast is predicting heavy rain, the instructor may have to postpone the experience. In this situation, as much notice will be provided to you and you will be given options to move to another date. Again, whilst we make every effort to ensure our workshops and experiences go ahead, the weather is something we cannot control.
